It gives me immense pleasure to report that all our initiatives have been operating at full throttle. We dedicated a total of Rs 2.6 crore to various initiatives and schemes, touching the lives of approximately 5500 students - from Street Schools to University graduates, our mission to provide education and opportunities has been relentless.

One of our best achievements this year was the continued success of our Structured Internship Initiative with NUV. Building upon the lessons learned from last year's maiden experience, we made the program even more effective. The 60 interns who participated this year and visited the house of more than 2600 applicants of our Open Scholarship Program, our flagship scheme. They not only helped us in allocating more than Rs.1.5 crore of scholarships to these beneficiaries but also expressed how it developed empathy, compassion, and gratitude within them. These values will undoubtedly play a pivotal role in shaping their futures and guiding them toward successful, purposeful, and meaningful lives.

Our ADMS program (After-School Development for Bright Primary Kids) and Kayakalp program (specifically designed for those in the science stream) for 9th to 12th-standard students, continue to flourish very well.

This year, after a hiatus of three years, we were thrilled to conduct our two flagship events - the Annual Cultural Evening and the Annual Sports Day. Both events were resounding successes, showcasing the talent and discipline of our students.

Our Annual Cultural Evening, held at the esteemed Sayajinagar Gruh Auditorium, received widespread acclaim. The overflowing audience witnessed outstanding performances from all participants, with Asha Deep's kids receiving a standing ovation. We paid tribute to our late Chairman, Dr. B C Jain, and pledged to carry forward his extraordinary vision for MI-MFT.

The Annual Sports Day, hosted at Billabong International High School, was a testament to the discipline, enthusiasm, and participation of Asha Deep and ADMS children who are mostly from the slums and are street children.

The Ashadeep program, our 'Street to School' initiative, has made significant strides, with 33 centers across Vadodara providing education to over 1000 children. We are proud of our academic and administrative coordinators and more than 45 teachers who work tirelessly to make learning engaging and innovative.

Our new program, Marg Darshan (Vocational Training Programme), in collaboration with Transpek Industries, has successfully completed two batches of wiremen/electricians, all of whom are either employed or self-employed. In just three months, these individuals have gained valuable skills that enable them to earn Rs 10-12k per month. We aim to expand this program to include various vocations like fitter, plumber, turner, solar technician, and more, opening up opportunities for the masses as the eligibility criteria are flexible, focusing on skill development and employability. The beauty of this program is that any student who has completed 18 years of age and is even 5th pass can apply and start earning. We have collaborated with many other institutions that are providing soft skill development to enlarge the scope of this program for our other beneficiaries as well.

In conclusion, I extend my heartfelt gratitude to all our donors, well-wishers, corporate partners, and members of the MI-MFT family. Your unwavering support has been the driving force behind our success. Together, we will continue to make a meaningful difference in the lives of those we serve.



# ADOPTED SCHOOLS INITIATIVE

- Started in 2001 and ongoing
- Mission: Support, motivate, and guide students of socio-economically disadvantaged communities
- Focus on High Schools/Higher Secondary level schools
- Active participation of MI members in selection of beneficiaries
- Many female students help their working mothers
- 342 students got cash awards and scholarships in 10 schools
- Bright students receive awards, others get scholarships in school events







# OPEN SCHOLARSHIP INITIATIVE

- Initiated in 2005 and ongoing
- Largest beneficiary outreach, flagship initiative of Mahavir Foundation Trust.
- Scholarships available from 8th grade to the completion of the first degree and also to Professional course students.
- Key features include continuous support, personal assessments (via house visits) by members, interns, and volunteers, and annual on-the-spot re-assessments
- Scholarship disbursements are usually in well-organized events.
- Assisted 3,400+ students with scholarships totalling Rs. 1.25 crores
- Emphasis on providing increased financial support and one-to-one mentoring to exceptionally bright students through Shining Star and Star initiatives
- Distribution of laptops, desktops, and tablets to deserving students







# ASHA DEEP (Street To School Initiative)

- Aim to educate marginalized children
- Centres in unconventional locations
- Operates 2-3 hours daily, 6days a week
- Provides formal education and holistic development
- Supplies uniforms, shoes, school bags and snacks
- Some students transition to Navprerna program
- Exceptional students receive special coaching at ADMS
- Dedicated teachers working to reintegrate students
- 820 children across 28 centers
- Community involvement due to public locations







## ASHA DEEP MENTOR-SPONSOR INITIATIVE

- Mentoring 79 bright and needy students (1st to 8th Standard)
- Located near Sursagar with innovative and asthetic premises
- Majority students from Ashadeep Centers, other from the weakest societal segment
- Student: Teacher ratio 10:1 for individualized attention
- Equal focus on extracurricular activities and overall development







## KAYAKALP INITIATIVE

- Aims to transform bright and needy students in grades 9 to 12 (Science Stream).
- Combines regular schooling with Kayakalp daily classes, lasting over 3 hours, held at Baroda High School, Danteshwar.
- Focus on developing values, personality, communication skills, life skills, and spoken English, in addition to academic improvement.
- Provides free transportation, study materials, uniforms, and other necessities.
- This year, 142 students have enrolled.
- Regular guest lectures arranged for career guidance and personality development.







# SAMVEDANA, HEALTH & HYGIENE

- Collection of clothes, toys, and household items from affluent or caring individuals
- Distribution of these items to recipients with sensitivity to their self-respect
- Has benefitted nearly 10,000 individuals
- Providing education on health and hygiene to young girls and women
- Regular distribution of sanitary pads as a part of this initiative
- Approximately 500 girls and women, benefitted including those from Asha Deep Centres and Kayakalp.







# NAYA SAVERA (Adult Education for Women)

#### **OBJECTIVE:**

- Educate mothers and elderly sisters of Asha Deep's kids and women near Asha Deep centers.
- Ensure beneficiaries attain basic reading and writing skills in the local language
- Enable beneficiaries to independently open and operate their bank accounts.
- Enhance financial literacy among the beneficiaries.

#### **CURRENT STATUS:**

7 operational centers serving 80 women.







- Three batches of wiremen/electricians have been successfully completed through this collaboration.
- All students from these batches are currently employed or self-employed.
- In just three months of training, participants have acquired skills that enable them to earn between Rs 10,000 to 15,000 per month in the beginning.
- Trying to collaborate with as many corporates or skill development institutions as possible.



## ANNUAL CULTURAL EVENING

- Held every year in a large auditorium
- Attendees included well-wishers, donors, volunteers, and more
- Event features competitive dancing musical entertainment
- Used for reconnecting and updating the audience on the year's work
- Participation of Students from Adopted Schools, Ashadeep, ADMS, its teachers & Kayakalp.
- Last Event took place on December 16th at Sayajinaar Gruh with a full capacity audience
- Paid tribute to the late chairman, Dr. B. C. Jain, for his vision and dedication

- Participation of all Ashadeep and ADMS students with great enthusiasm
